



UOW FEEDBACK COMPETITION

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

You warrant and represent that you have full power, capacity and authority to accept these terms and conditions of entry (terms and conditions). Entrants under 18 years old ('a minor') must have parental/guardian approval to enter and further, the parent/guardian of the minor must also read and consent to these terms and conditions.

BY ENTERING THIS COMPETITION, YOU AGREE TO ABIDE BY THESE TERMS AND CONDITIONS.

1. Information on how to enter the "Feedback UOW Competition" (**Competition**) and prizes form part of these terms and conditions of entry (**Terms and Conditions**).
2. By entering this Competition, you (the **Entrant**) agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions.
3. The promoter of the Competition is the University of Wollongong ABN 61 060 567 686, of Northfields Avenue, Wollongong, NSW, 2522 Australia (**UOW**).
4. The Competition commences at 12.00am AEST on Tuesday, 1 May 2018 and closes at 11.59pm AEST on Thursday, 31 May 2018 (**Competition Period**).

Entry to Competition

5. To enter the Competition, Entrants must, during the Competition Period, submit feedback through www.feedback.uow.edu.au (**Entry**).
6. Feedback can be in the form of a comment, complaint, compliment or suggestion.
7. Feedback submitted 'anonymously' will not be considered in the Prize draw. That is, Entrants must specify their relevant contact details as required for their Entry to constitute a valid Entry that is eligible for the Competition.
8. Entrants can submit more than one Entry.
9. Entry into the Competition is for no fee.
10. Entrants must reside in Australia and be a current enrolled student at UOW (during the Competition Period) at an onshore UOW campus (including Wollongong campus, Innovation Campus, South Western Sydney Campus, Shoalhaven Campus, UOW Sydney Business School, or at any UOW Education Centre e.g. Batemans Bay, Bega, Moss Vale, Southern Sydney), or a member of the general public.
11. UOW employees are not eligible to enter the Competition.
12. Entries are deemed to be received when the feedback is received through UOW's feedback channel. UOW is not responsible for any delay in, or failure of, transmission which causes an Entry not to be received within the Competition Period.
13. This promotional draw is conducted as a gratuitous lottery. This draw is not being conducted for the purpose of promoting trade or business.
14. Entrants should ensure that UOW can contact them via SOLSMail in the event that the Entrant is the successful Competition winner.

The Prize

20. The Competition winners will be notified in writing on or before Friday, 8 June 2018 by SOLSMail.
21. The Competition winners will be provided with written confirmation that they have won, and will be provided with details of how to claim their Prize and the date by which they must do so.
22. The winner's name may be published on the UOW Website and/or MyUOW mobile application.
23. Prizes must be collected from Building 17, Student Central, Wollongong Campus.

24. If the Prize is unclaimed for two weeks by a successful Competition winner, UOW reserves the right to select a new Competition winner by conducting a secondary draw from the valid remaining Entries.
